## Description

Kodiak is a Canadian granite from a quarry in Chutes-des-Passes in the Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean area, Quebec. Its excavation started in 1990, bringing back to life the region's economy. With its medium brown and black hues and subtle texture, this granite is most fascinating by the way it absorbs and reflects light. Often compared to the Antique Brown, this profound and mysterious granite with a perfectly homogeneous mineral structure will resist to chipping and is extremely durable.
