Description

Santa Cecilia is one of the most popular granites in Brazil. Named after Santa Cecilia, a Christian martyr and patron of sacred music. This granite is extracted in Espirito Santo, in Brazil, renowned for its beautiful beaches, coastal cuisine and sand dunes. It features large elongated deep yellow crystals. Its golden colouration is the result of oxidation, which took place over millions of years. It is also possible to see brownish and black biotite crystals in the stone, a tribute to the region's warm character.

Each slab has its own complexity. It is therefore very difficult to find two identical slabs. The stone's colour will also vary according to the depth at which it was excavated: the slabs taken on the surface will be more golden and those taken deeper in the ground will carry a creamier colouration because water will not have had the time to oxidize the stone yet.
